The new LED marquee sign at the Middle School was recently dedicated in memory of Mark “Doc” Schweitzer. The Schweitzer family donated \$20,000 for the purchase of the sign in honor of Mark.

Mr. Mark Schweitzer taught in the Beaver Dam Unified School District for 27 years, spending most of his time teaching social studies at the middle school. Mr. Schweitzer was an active member of our learning community, leading many endeavors that helped enrich the learning experiences of our students. Mr. Schweitzer dedicated countless hours coaching and refereeing athletic contests throughout our community and school district. The community of Beaver Dam sadly lost Mr. Schweitzer in October, 2013 to a 40 year fight with Crohn’s Disease and a short battle with cancer.
