## **Beaver Dam Unified School District Board of Education Minutes**

## July 18, 2022

The Beaver Dam Unified School District Board of Education held a special meeting on the above date at the Educational Service Center. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by President, Chad Prieve. Mr. Peters, District Assessment and Technology Officer, provided an update on 2021-2022 strategic actions and data. He gave a brief overview of the core strategies and strategic objectives.
