## Madeline "Maddy" Horn 1998 Outstanding Alumnus

Maddy Horn is a 1934 High School graduate and an internationally acclaimed speed skater. She competed in Canada, the United States, and Europe. In 1937, she held seven out of ten world records in women's skating. In 1938, she won second place in the World Championships in Oslo, Norway. Horn was the only woman speed skater chosen to represent the United States in the 1940 Olympics. Unfortunately, the games were canceled when the United States entered World War II. In her last sixty-seven races, Horn won sixty-four first place medals. To this day, she owns the world record in the 220-yard sprint.
