Bill served as a member and president of the Beaver Dam Chamber of Commerce and provided leadership in many activities to better the community. They were also active in promoting and maintaining Rawhide, a camp for underprivileged youth.

Bill and Eddie Woods were not only committed to education while they lived, but that commitment will be exemplified for many years through their Scholarship Trust Fund.
