Teaching and Learning Committee Meeting

October 10, 2022

A meeting of the Teaching and Learning Committee of the Board of Education was held on the above date at the Educational Service Center at 5:30 p.m. Board committee members present: Mary Kuntz, Maria Mason, Lisa Panzer, and Gary Spielman.

Mr. Meyer, Director of Teaching and Learning, reported that a revision of the Science curriculum is due during 2022-23 and revisions will be implemented in the 2023-34 school year. He reviewed the steps involved in the review process and said that there are likely to be recommended changes at the High School due to licensure and certification concerns. Similar programming may be able to be provided with more flexibility to sustain pathways.

Mr. Meyer updated the committee on Response to Intervention (RtI) implementation. He explained that the focus of RtI work is a response to the district's strategic plan core strategies and District Strategic Actions. He reviewed the tiers of the RtI at Work pyramid along with the accomplishments and next steps.

Mr. Meyer presented an outline of the new course proposals and revisions for the high school. New course proposals include Medical Terminology (transcripted course with MPTC), Advanced Strength & Conditioning and Heritage Spanish 2. Principles of Sustainability is a new course that is a revision to the current Environmental Studies Science course and provides an option for trascripted course with MPTC.
