Teaching and Learning Committee Meeting

February 27, 2023

A meeting of the Teaching and Learning Committee of the Board of Education was held on the above date at the Educational Service Center at 5:30 p.m. Board committee members present: Mary Kuntz, Maria Mason, and Gary Spielman. Absent: Lisa Panzer

Mr. Meyer, Director of Teaching and Learning, provided an update on Human Growth and Development topics and targets. He explained that the Human Growth and Development Committee was established per state statute and board policy. The committee's purpose is to develop a Human Growth and Development curriculum and recommend topics to be studied and the sequence of study to the board. He shared information from the committee meetings and provided an overview of the proposed topics and learning targets for Human Growth and Development curriculum. He reviewed the next steps which includes board adoption and/or modification of the proposed topics and learning targets and then the creation of a curriculum plan with review and feedback from the Human Growth and Development committee.

Mr. Peters, District Assessment and Technology Officer, provided an update on district data metrics. He shared enrollment, attendance, behavioral, and financial data. He shared the current targets for achievement data, graduation rates, student and staff engagement, and family satisfaction data and said current year data will be available late spring/early summer. He reviewed the progress for each school's School Success Plan. Next steps include continuing staff collaboration around the four questions of Professional Learning Communities, using winter performance data to adjust targeted student supports and preparing students for spring assessments.
