Teaching and Learning Committee Meeting

June 20, 2022

A meeting of the Teaching and Learning Committee of the Board of Education was held on the above date at the Educational Service Center at 5:30 p.m. Board committee members present: Mary Kuntz, Maria Mason, Lisa Panzer, and Gary Spielman.

The Committee reviewed the Board Standing Committee Guidelines. They discussed the prospect of conducting committee meetings on the same date as the Board's Operation Committee meetings.

Lisa Panzer was selected as Committee Chairperson.

Mr. Meyer, Director of Teaching and Learning, reported on procedural updates and planning for 2022-2023. He reviewed the Teaching and Learning focus and overall focus areas, the Professional Development Plan, and the Academic Standards for 2022-2023. He explained that the board annually adopts the Student Academic Standards for the district. He provided an overview of the district's curriculum and materials, including an update on the review cycle and warehouse, and explained the board annually adopts the curriculum, utilizing the standards with the understanding that there are continued processes for development. Some courses are under current revision and will be revised/added as they are complete. He shared the support plan for students who may be at risk and explained that the board annually adopts a plan to support students who may at risk of not graduating with their peer group. He shared a recommended motion to be presented at the regular July board of education meeting that will adopt these overarching components of the procedural plan and updates for 2022-2023.

Mr. Meyer presented the end of the year Achievement Gap Reduction (AGR) report. He reviewed the reading and math data along with the AGR strategy. Lincoln, Jefferson, and Washington Elementary Schools are AGR schools.
