## **Reader's Workshop**

This week we are moving into a Module focused on Animal Behaviors, This will be perfect for our next major writing assignment. Students have read an informational text called, This is Your Life Cycle. They have explore text and graphic features, author's purpose, and author's craft.

### Math

We have started a new unit on fractions this week. Students have been identifying parts of a whole and will begin learning about fractions on a number line later this week.

Please continue to practice those facts at home with your child, especially as our main focus during whole group math will not be multiplication.

# Writing/ Grammar

The students have begun expository writing this week as they research an animal of their choosing. We are working on writing complete paragraphs with topic sentences, body paragraphs citing text evidence, and conclusions.

In grammar we are discussing adjectives, a word that describes a noun.
