Reading

This week we read *Dear Dragon*, a story about unusual pen pals that write to one another. This has fit in perfectly with our writing over the last couple of weeks. :)

Math

We are working on multiplication strategies all week this week for solving multiplication facts for 3s, 4s, and 6s! Students have also been practicing their x3's skip counting song! They have learned that they can use the break apart strategy to solve larger facts. For example, 4×6 could be solved by breaking the 6 into 4×5 and 4×1 and adding the products together.

Writing/ Grammar

The students are wrapping up their pen pal letters to the students at Washington Elementary this week.

In grammar, students are learning more about action and being verbs.

Social Studies

The students have been learning more about the elements of geography this week and how it affects where they live. These items include landforms, bodies of water, and the climate!

Science

Students have been exploring various forces at work this week as we created Hopper Poppers! We explored how these creations worked, and whether the forces were pushes or pulls.
