Reading

The students have read various realistic fiction texts this week as we work on skills like identifying the point of view (who is telling the story) and literary elements (characters, setting, and plot). Students will eventually be bringing books home to read, after multiple reads at school!

Math

This week in math, we have begun rounding numbers to the nearest tens and hundreds place. Students have brought home the Family Newsletter to go along with the lesson, so that you are aware of what your child will be learning. Completing the activity on the back is optional, but can be turned in for extra Dojo points.:)

Writing/ Grammar

Students have practiced brainstorming ideas for writing personal narratives and narrowing down a large idea into a small moment. They are creating interesting hook introductions and creating a story that has a beginning, middle, and end.

We are also identifying the parts of a sentence-subject and predicate. Finally, we are determining whether a sentence is a sentence or sentence fragment.

Social Studies

We have begun our first social studies chapter, which focuses on maps and globes. We will continue to explore this concept as students learn about different types of maps and the elements of a map. We also created a Memorial Quilt in honor of those affected by the events that occurred on September 11th, 2001.

Science

Students have just begun a new science unit this week that focuses on Animals Through Time. Students have been posed a question: How can there be whales in the desert? We will explore the possibilities this week!
