Child Abuse/Neglect (CAN) Report

Instructions: Wisconsin law requires ALL employees of Wisconsin public school districts to report suspected child abuse and neglect, Wis. Stat. sec. 48.981(2)(a) 16m. Employees are considered to be anyone who receives an annual statement of wages for tax purposes (W-2 form) from the school district. Any school district employee having reasonable cause to suspect that a child seen in the course of their professional duties has been abused or neglected or having reason to believe that a child has been threatened with an injury and that abuse will occur, are required to contact the appropriate county human services office or local law enforcement agency. Please complete the information below before making the call to report. Call Intake at 920-386-3750 to report the findings to Dodge County Human Services. After making the call, fax a copy of the report to 920-386-3533. Provide a copy of this form to the building Principal and keep the original. For reports to local law enforcement, most reports will be given to our Student Resource Officers (SRO).
